Participants with low incomes in the HELPNM employment initiatives obtained supports which reduced or eliminated barriers to initial or continuous employment, acquired a job, increased their income or achieved "living wage" employment and benefits.



Households with low incomes increased their financial assets or financial skills.



Vulnerable individuals with low incomes received services from the HELPNM and secured or maintained an independent living situation as a result.



Participants with low incomes obtained supports which reduced or eliminated barriers to family stability through assistance from HELPNM.



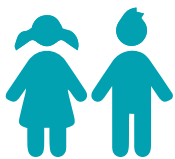
Individuals and families with low incomes received emergency assistance from HELPNM.



Community opportunities or resources were improved or expanded for people with low incomes as a result of HELPNM projects, initiatives, or partnerships with other public and private agencies.

The well-being of children, adults, and families are strengthened and enhanced through access to early childhood education, health, nutrition, parenting education, adult and family relationships.

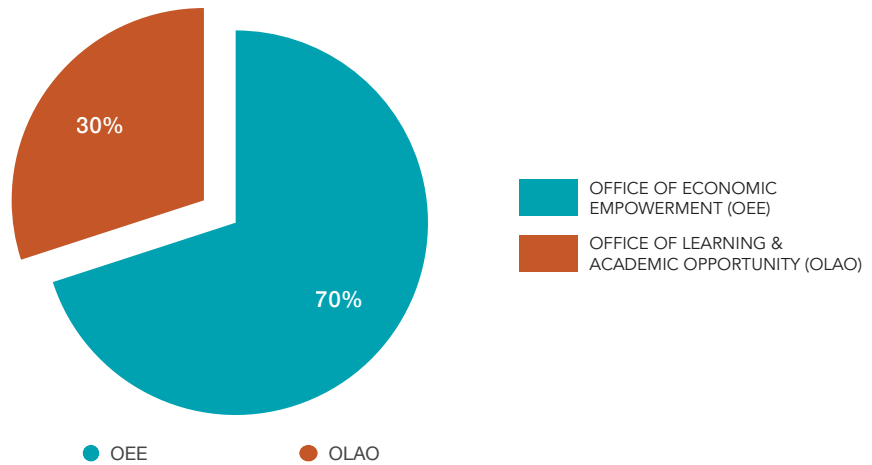

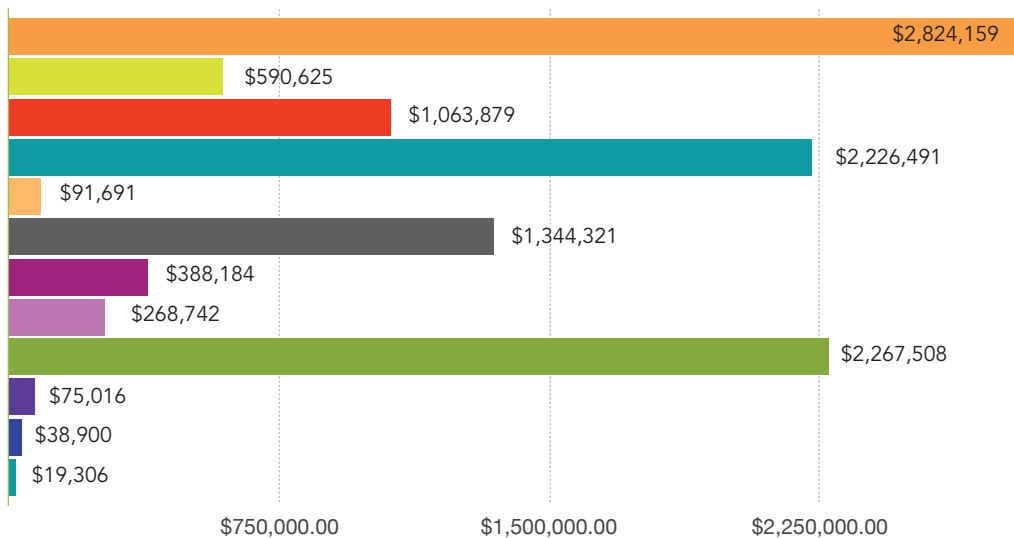


2018 HELP NEW MEXICO INC. FINANCIAL SUMMARY

= \$16,120,909



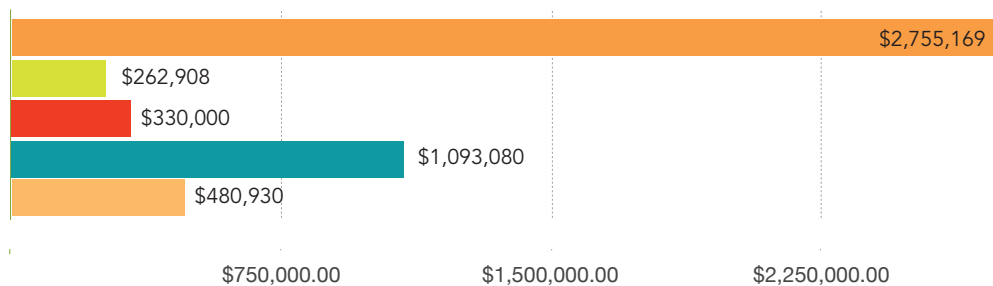
