NATIONAL FARMWORKER JOBS PROGRAM (NFJP)

You may qualify for our services if:

- You or anyone in your household worked as an agricultural laborer in the past 24 months; OR
- You sell or have sold livestock and have valid receipts or bill of sales; OR
- You paid for breaking, horseshoeing, castrating, vaccinating, herding or general care of livestock; OR
- You grow and sell crops and have receipts from the sale; OR
- You are a dependent of a farmworker; AND
- You are 16 years or older; AND
- You qualify as low income

Documents needed to determine eligibility:

- Valid Drivers License or ID
- Social Security cards and proof of age for ALL household members
- Selective Service registration for all males 18 and over
- Total household income for past 12 months, including any public assistance (check stubs, award letters, proof of sales from crops, livestock, etc)
