## Workforce Innovation and Opportunity Act

The federal Workforce Innovation and Opportunity Act funds programs designed for adult and dislocated workers over the age of 18 to find employment, stay employed, earn or increase wages and learn occupational skills to succeed in today's workforce.

### Tuition Assistance Program

If eligible you can receive up to \$15,000 in tuition assistance to help pay for your education depending on your field of study. This amount can cover tuition fees, books and supplies.



### Supporting Services Assistance Program

Supportive services assist students by lowering the financial barriers to obtaining an education. For those who qualify, the assistance is provided in the following areas & communities:

- Transportation assistance
- Child care assistance
- Education-related temporary housing assistance
- Books/ Fees
- Medical & Health
- Uniforms, Certificate fees, Testing Fees
- Core Supportive Services

### Eligibility Requirements

To qualify for tuition assistance, you are required to:

- 18 or older
- An U.S. citizen or authorized to work in the U.S.
- Be in compliance with the Selective Service Act (if applicable)
- Provide dislocation verification if you have been laid off
